## CAMP SESSIONS

### LEARNING TO LOOK

**AGES 8-10**  
July 14 - July 18 9:00am - 4:00pm

Through a series of fun activities, students will learn the basics of photography such as composing an image, perspective, balance, and color. They will explore traditional and non-traditional photographic processes to make and manipulate images and ideas. This camp will also teach students how to look at and engage with their world more critically in order to capture interesting photographic images, while fostering their creativity and expression.

### KIDS TODAY

Students will consider their lives, their city, and their concerns as subjects to create a book of their own photographs. They will learn about street photography, portraiture, narrative and constructed imagery, and other photographic approaches, as well as how to make and edit images for a book and write the accompanying text.

Working in small groups, students will learn how to create both photo-journalistic and constructed or imaginary photo stories. They will spend part of the week developing "news" stories while learning how to create documentary images. They will also learn how to fabricate imaginary stories using a variety of photographic techniques. Students will investigate potential stories and subjects, photograph those subjects, edit and sequence their stories, and publish them in a finished book.
