



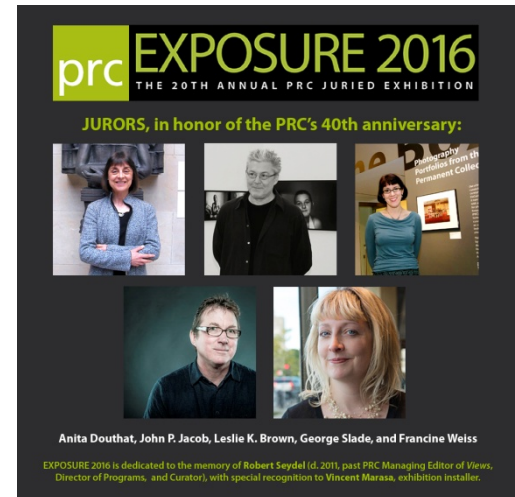
## Juror Announcement for EXPOSURE: The 20th Annual PRC Juried Exhibition

*In honor of its 40th anniversary and the 20th annual juried show, the PRC announces a special, multiple juror, iteration of its nationally-renowned competition*

**Entry Deadline:** February 7, 2016 (via [callforentry.org](http://callforentry.org)) | **Exhibition dates:** April 28 – June 26, 2016

**BOSTON, MA:** Each year, the PRC hosts a **highly-regarded juried exhibition of photography and related media**, showcasing emerging and midcareer photographers. Notably, in 2015/2016, the PRC celebrates *three* important anniversaries: the **30th anniversary of the PRC Gallery** (added with the renovation of our previous space at 602 Commonwealth Avenue, opening November 8, 1985); **2016 is the 40th anniversary of the PRC itself** (incorporated as a non-profit on October 6, 1976); and EXPOSURE 2016 will be the **20th annual juried exhibition**.

**To pay homage to this 20/40 confluence, the PRC asked multiple jurors, instead of our usual one. Thus, for EXPOSURE 2016 there will be a chorus of voices, all of whom held positions as past PRC curators or director of exhibitions.** Additionally, we are pleased to present EXPOSURE 2016 **as a part of Magenta Foundation's Flash Forward Festival in Boston, MA (May 1-8)** and the opening reception will coincide with their schedule of festivities, Thursday, May 5th. We're honored and grateful to have this group of incredible photographic curators, gallerists, educators, and scholars and delighted that the occasion acknowledges and **commemorates our past, and also celebrates and looks to the future!**



**The call for entries is again via [callforentries.org](http://callforentries.org), aka CaFÉ, now open and online HERE (or search for EXPOSURE, under view all calls keyword search), with a submission deadline of February 7th.** There are many reasons to enter this year's special opportunity and the **EXPOSURE is increased exponentially.** In order to submit, entrants must be PRC members, share up to 10 images, a CV, and short statement, pay an entry fee, and follow the guidelines noted online. **The PRC asks jurors to select several images from a submitted series, thus representing each artist's work more fully than a single image.** Hundreds of photographers enter, with typically 10-15 selected and 2 to 5 works displayed per each artist, distinguishing our offering from other juried photographic shows. Since its inception in 1996, over 300 photographers have shown in the *PRC Juried Exhibitions*. In celebration of the PRC's 30th anniversary in 2006/2007 and to reflect more accurately its mission and function, we changed the name of the *PRC Members' Exhibition* to *EXPOSURE: The Annual PRC Juried Exhibition*.
